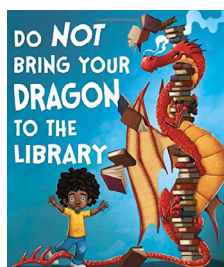
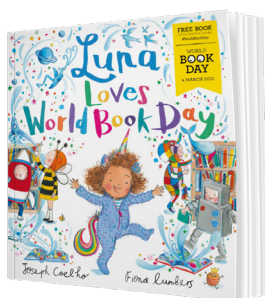


# What to read next after your World Book Day book

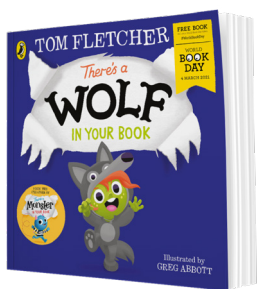

A fun cautionary tale about what happens if you try to take your Dragon to the library... but your Dragon loves to read so how do you get books for him?



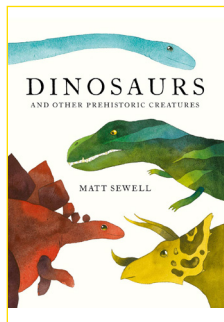
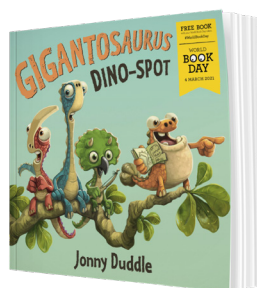
**One Button Benny**

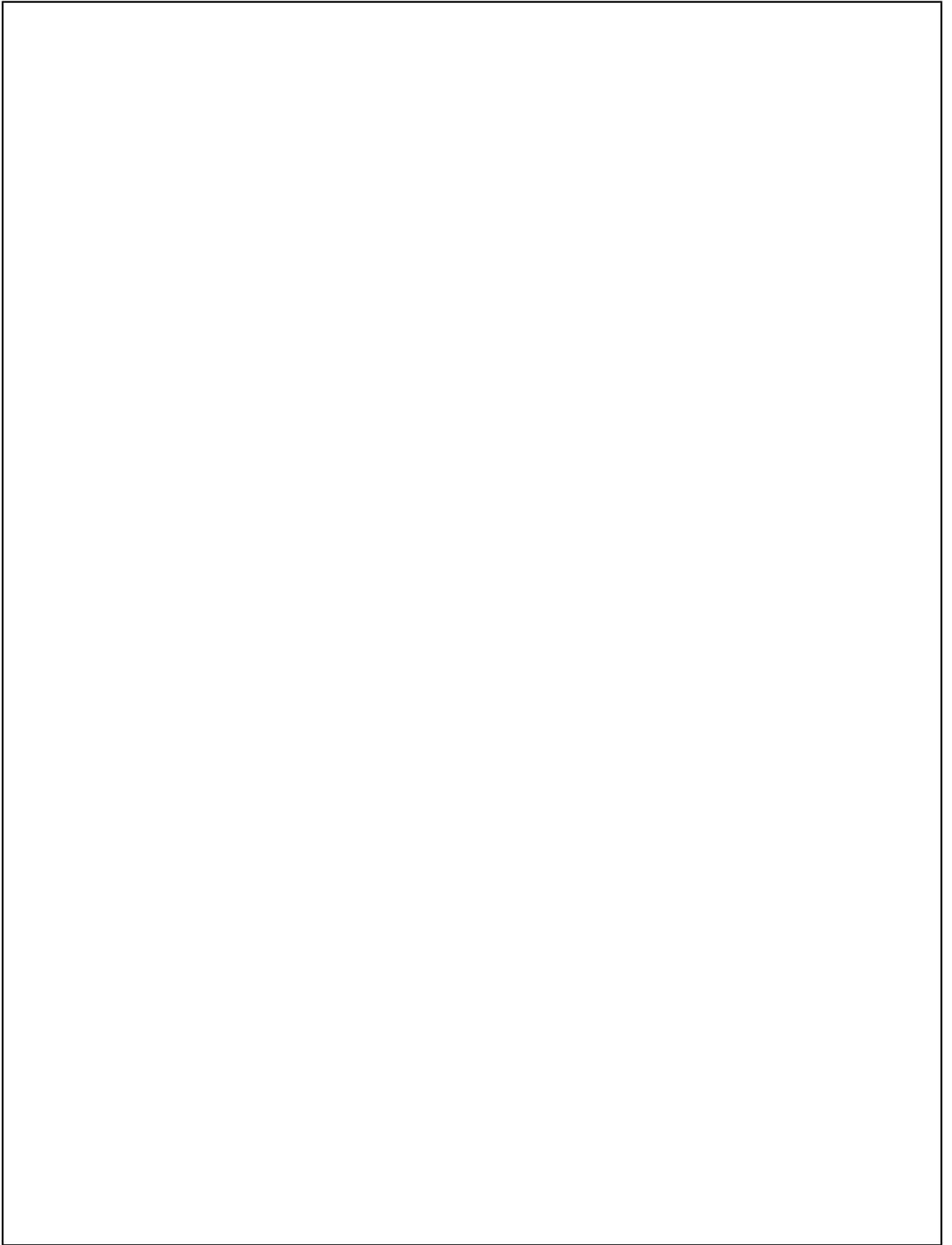
**The True Story of the Three Little Pigs**
